

DIRECTV to broadcast all matches of the FIFA U-20 World Cup 2023

The entertainment company acquired the rights to broadcast all 52 matches of the youth championship that will take place from May 20 to June 11.

DSPORTS will offer the most extensive coverage, which will be available on **DGO**.

The group draw will be available on DSPORTS this Friday 21, from 11 a.m.

Buenos Aires, April 18, 2023 — DIRECTV Latin America will broadcast all 52 matches of the 2023 FIFA U-20 World Cup starting on May 20, with five Latin American teams in the tournament.

The leading company in sports broadcasting and entertainment programming in the region acquired the broadcasting rights for the entire country, following the confirmation of Argentina as the host country for the tournament.

DSPORTS, DIRECTV Latin America's exclusive sports signal, will broadcast all the matches, so the company's customers will be able to watch the games through satellite TV or through the **DGO** streaming platform, on a cell phone, tablet or computer.

Between Saturday, May 20 and Sunday, June 11, the date when the finals will be played, DSPORTS will offer in-depth coverage of the championship, which brings together twenty-four youth soccer teams.

The broadcasting of all the matches on **DSPORTS** will be backed up by coverage from the stadiums and special reports whenever the Argentine national team, coached by Javier Mascherano, participates in the event.

The draw to determine which teams will face each other in the group stage will be held this Friday 21 in Zürich, at the headquarters of the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA). The event will be broadcast on DSPORTS (channels 610 / 1610 HD) from 11 a.m. onwards.

Argentina will play the championship as the host country, following the withdrawal of Indonesia as the original host. Brazil, Uruguay, Colombia and Ecuador qualified for South America; for Europe, England, France, Italy, Israel and Slovakia; for Asia, South Korea, Japan, Uzbekistan, New Zealand and Iraq; for Oceania, Fiji; for Africa, Gambia, Senegal, Tunisia and Nigeria; and for Central and North America, the United States, Honduras, Guatemala and the Dominican Republic.
