

DSports and DGO will broadcast all 64 matches of the 2022 FIFA World Cup in Qatar

The sports signal will be the only one to broadcast all World Cup matches, live and in 4K Ultra HD, with 24/7 programming entirely dedicated to soccer's greatest event. All content will be available on DGO. In addition, the streaming platform will offer tools and information that will further enrich the user experience.

On November 14, the first live program will be broadcast from the company's own studios in Doha.

DSports Radio FM 103.1 is already in the Middle East to broadcast all the matches. Sebastián "Pollo" Vignolo, Enrique Macaya Márquez and Marcelo Benedetto will provide their voices to the presentations of the Argentine National Team.

What does DIRECTV offer?

The transmission of the 64 matches, live and in 4K Ultra HD, will be complemented by the original content of *DSports*, *DSports* 2 and *DSports* +, an interactive mosaic with its multi-camera proposal and the availability of the summaries of each match to get the most important highlights of each day.

DSports 610/1610 HD will be the flagship signal. The participation of the Argentinean, Ecuadorian and Uruguayan national teams will be covered by local reporters and commentaries to personalize the coverage through the narration of each match.

The information will be available on **DSports 2 (612/1612 HD)** through live coverage and news from the practice sessions, the transmission of press conferences and exclusive programming with the participation of all the sports journalists' staff. The spokesperson for the Argentine National Team will be Fede Rodas.

DSports + (613/1613 HD) will provide a multi-camera proposal so that customers can access all the details and behind-the-scenes of the World Cup with the possibility of interacting through social networks. The highlights of each match will be shown on **614 and 1614 HD**.

As is usual in each FIFA World Cup, the interactive mosaic (**601 and 1601 HD**) will be available in the service's programming grid and will allow the user to select the way to follow a match through four cameras.

Finally, the **QATAR PORTAL** will be located on 600 and 1600 HD. The interactive signal will unify the information of each day, fixture, standings and statistics of all matches being played live.

The radio station started broadcasting live from Qatar on Monday, November 7 and will broadcast all 64 matches. Sebastian "*El Pollo*" Vignolo will be the voice that will narrate all the matches of the Argentine National Team together with the commentaries of Enrique Macaya Márquez and Marcelo Benedetto.

The broadcast of all matches will be complemented by a varied programming led by Gastón Recondo, Ariel Senosiaín, Diego Korol and Gustavo Kuffner, and the participation of Juan Pablo Varsky and Sergio Goycochea.
