The radio station, which airs on FM 103.1, has programming entirely dedicated to sports and is headed by renowned hosts and journalists, celebrated its first anniversary with special guests.

The station has outstanding journalists such as Gastón Recondo, Ariel Senosiaín, Marcelo Benedetto, Gustavo Kuffner, Hernán Feler, Emiliano Pinsón, Sergio Goycochea, Julián Fernández, Daniel Retamozo, Héctor Gallo, Silvio Maverino, Narella Senra, Cecilia Ruffa, Milena Gimón and the legendary Enrique Macaya Márquez, star commentator in the broadcasts of Argentina's National Team matches.

Darío Werthein, president of Vrio Corp, greeted all the members of **DSPORTS Radio**: "It is a team and a family that puts heart and determination, that works professionally and competitively. What we have built from 6 o'clock in the morning until midnight is really wonderful and that allows us to grow, reaching already 12 Argentine provinces , and we will continue to add more".

"I appreciate the family spirit, of wanting to build something that is much bigger than all of us together, with the radio collaborators as protagonists, giving their voice, emotions, feelings and professionalism. We are one year old, but we are just starting. And we are already preparing to broadcast the 2030 World Cup", commented Werthein.

And today we can happily say: We were born to be champions! With DSPORTS Radio, dozens of jobs were created, with growth for the professionals who are part of it and for those who are related to sports".

Recondo interviewed the former soccer player and current Technical Director of Platense, Martín Palermo, who reflected on the importance of sports in society, on what it meant to him to have dedicated his life to professional soccer and made an analysis of the situation of this discipline, with the present of the Argentine National Team after winning the World Cup in Qatar 2022.
