

The fifth season of the hit anthology series **Fargo** premieres exclusively on DIRECTV.

Buenos Aires, November 7, 2023 — DIRECTV, the leading media tech company in connectivity, entertainment and information in Latin America, will premiere the fifth season of **Fargo**, the Emmy, AFI, Peabody and TCA award-winning anthology series created for television, written, directed and produced by Noah Hawley, on Thursday, November 23 at 9 p.m.

Juno Temple, Jon Hamm, Jennifer Jason Leigh, David Rysdahl, Joe Keery, Lamorne Morris, Richa Moorjani, Sam Spruell and Dave Foley star in the new season of the hit series, which can be seen on OnDIRECTV, on channels 201 and 1201 HD of DIRECTV's programming grid and on its live TV and streaming service [DGO](#).

Fargo's new season is set in Minnesota and North Dakota in 2019. After an unexpected series of events lands Dorothy "Dot" Lyon (**Juno Temple**) in trouble with the authorities, this seemingly typical housewife finds herself plunged back into a life she thought she had left behind.

North Dakota Sheriff Roy Tillman (**Jon Hamm**) has been looking for Dot for a long time. Roy believes he is the law and, therefore, above it. By his side, is his loyal but feckless son, Gator (**Joe Keery**), desperate to prove himself to his father. Too bad, he's hopeless. Then, when it comes to hunting Dot, Roy recruits Ole Munch (**Sam Spruell**), a shady drifter with a mysterious background.

With her deepest secrets beginning to unravel, Dot tries to protect her family from her past, but her loving and well-meaning husband Wayne (**David Rysdahl**) runs for help to her mother, Lorraine Lyon (**Jennifer Jason Leigh**). The CEO of the nation's largest debt collection agency, the "Queen of Debt," misses no opportunity to express her disapproval with her son's choice of wife. However, when Dot's unusual behavior draws the attention of Minnesota police officer Indira Olmstead (**Richa Moorjani**) and North Dakota deputy Witt Farr (**Lamorne Morris**), Lorraine appoints her attorney and chief counsel, Danish Graves (**Dave Foley**), to help her daughter-in-law. After all, family is family. However, Dot has an uncanny knack for survival. And, up against the wall, she's about to prove why a mother Lyon should never be provoked.



Noah Hawley serves as showrunner, executive producer, writer and director and leads the creative team for the new installment of the series with his production company 26 Keys. The first two episodes are written and directed by Hawley.

Warren Littlefield (The Handmaid's Tale, The Old Man, Dopesick) and his production company The Littlefield Company, is also executive producing along with Toluca Pictures' Steve Stark (Vikings: Valhalla, Wednesday, The Consultant), Kim Todd (The Handmaid's Tale, Brave New World) and Joel and Ethan Coen. **Fargo** is produced by MGM Television and FX Productions, with MGM Television serving as lead studio. The series is distributed internationally by Amazon MGM Studios Distribution.

When and where to watch the series?

The fifth season of **Fargo** will premiere exclusively in Latin America on OnDIRECTV — DIRECTV channels 201 and 1201 HD — and via streaming on [DGO](#) on Thursday, November 23 at 9 p.m. with a double episode. Starting the following Thursday, an episode will be broadcast every week at the same hour.

In addition, to catch up before the big premiere, OnDIRECTV will air the previous four seasons on the weekends leading up to it. On Saturday, November 11 and Sunday, November 12 from 2 p.m., seasons 1 and 2 will be broadcast and a week later, on Saturday, November 18 and Sunday, November 19, seasons 3 and 4 will be aired.
